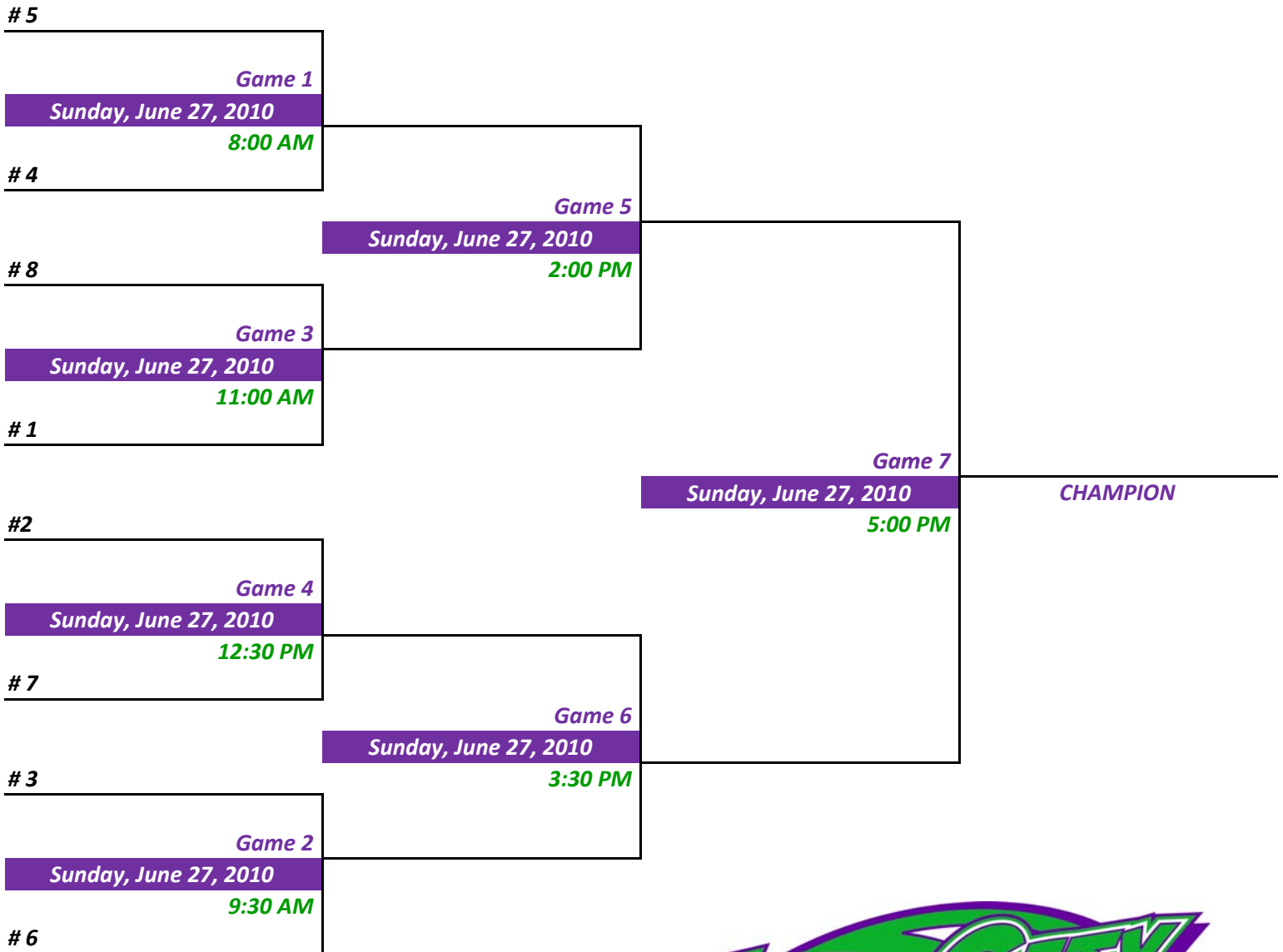

## 2010 Frog City Tune Up Bronco League Tournament Information

- Bronco teams must check in 30 minutes prior to first game at North Concession to receive packet and coaches passes. **All coaches will pay to enter on first playing date and will be reimbursed at check in.**
- All Game will have a 1 hour and 30 minute time limit. There is no drop dead. We will complete the inning that is started, but will not start another inning after 1 hour and 20 minutes.
- During Pool Play, teams will be allowed to submit a batting order that contains one of the following:
  - ❖ All available players. If this option is utilized, the batting order must remain the same for the entire game.
  - ❖ The AH option, where teams will submit a batting order that has an additional player.
- Games will be 7 innings. There will be a (15 after 3) and (10 after 5) mercy rule. **Pitchers can throw a total of 10 innings for the weekend, but no more than 7 in one day. If a pitcher throws more than 4 innings in a day he cannot throw the next day. One pitch in an inning constitutes 1 inning. Umpires will keep pitching records.**
- Home team will keep official book.
- Entry fee will be \$150 payable to Rayne Recreation Department. Game balls will be provided.
- Admission will be \$5.00 adults, \$2.00 students, and children 5 and under free.
- **No outside food or drinks will be permitted. Only Florida water coolers will be allowed.**
- All Bronco games will be played on Field 4. (Located on southeast side of northern complex).
- Players, coaches, and spectators will be expected to show good sportsmanship. There will be zero tolerance for misconduct by players, coaches, and spectators. In the event that a spectator gets ejected he/she will leave the park and not return for the day.
